


## Yahara Kickoff

 Two families signed up, will be started on streams in spring 2025






## Yahara Stream Monitoring Summary

#### 2024:

- 53 baseline monitoring sites
- 42 nutrient monitoring sites
- 25 continuous temperature monitoring sites

## Slight Decrease in Numbers from 2023:

 Due to compounding effect of high volunteer retirement and low recruitment
